Still Water Lodge offers the perfect place to escape the rush of everyday life and find rest for the mind, body, and soul.

Lodging is suite style, with each suite having either two bedrooms and one bath or three bedrooms and two baths. You can choose to share a room or have a bedroom to yourself. All suites have private balconies overlooking the river.



The Café Rio dining room will provide dinner buffets on Friday and Saturday evenings, and breakfast buffets on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Saturday lunch is “on your own,” with Glen Rose offering many options.
