

Comments for Contemplation

The Risen Christ, Our Life Colossians 3:1–4; John 20:1–18

1. What unites us is that we are all celebrating the resurrection from the dead of our Lord Jesus Christ. To someone who had never heard of such a thing, this would seem a very _____ thing to be doing. If you haven't heard of Jesus Christ, you probably haven't heard of someone rising from the dead. I would submit to you today that Jesus' resurrection from the grave is the most important event in human history, bar none.
2. Apart from Jesus' resurrection, we would have no assurance of a just God who deeply cares about a suffering world, we would have no assurance that there is anything redemptive about suffering, we would have no assurance of the hope of living in a right relationship with God and our neighbor, and we would have no assurance of being saved from the power of sin and _____.
3. (N.T. Wright): "Crucifixion was not a private event. Jewish revolutionaries whose leader had been executed by the authorities, and who managed to escape arrest themselves, had two options: give up the revolution, or find another leader. Claiming that the original leader was alive again was not an _____. Unless, of course, he was."
4. (Tim Keller): "No one has come up with any plausible alternative to this claim. Even if you propose the highly unlikely idea that one or two of Jesus' disciples did get the idea that [Jesus] was raised from the dead on their own, they would never have gotten a movement of other Jews to believe it unless there were multiple, inexplicable, plausible, repeated encounters with _____."
5. But Jesus quite intentionally makes Mary the first bearer of the good news of Jesus' resurrection, showing that women, and men, as well the disabled, Gentiles, slaves, free, Jews and Greeks would be a part of his kingdom work. His resurrection is for the whole _____.

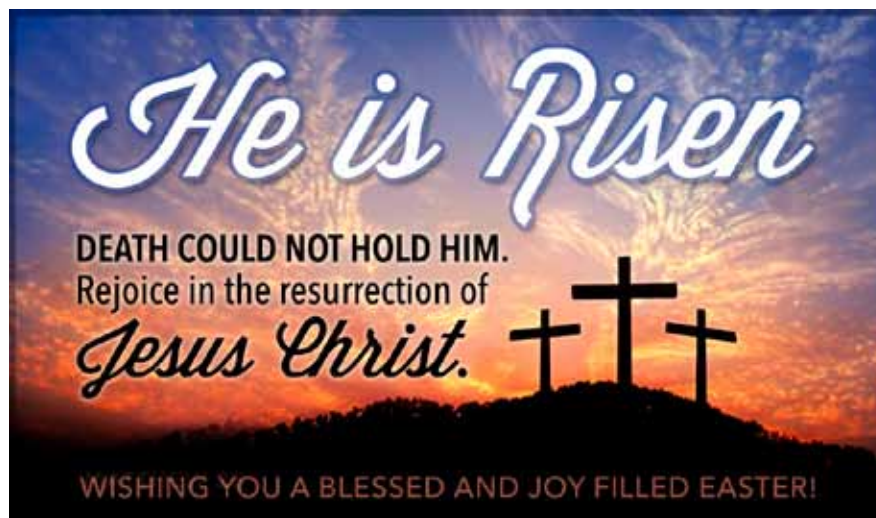
