Comments for Contemplation

Learning to Trust the Shepherd Mark 6:1–13, 30–34

- 1. What we find in Mark's gospel is that a number of people that we might expect to understand and to get the point, don't. The crowds that observe his miracles don't get it, his disciples don't get it, the religious authorities don't get it, his family doesn't get it and even the people in his ______ town of Nazareth, about whom we read today, don't get it. They miss the point of who Jesus really is.
- 2. On the other hand, when we learn to trust Jesus, to have faith in and believe in him, amazing, incredible and even miraculous things can and do happen. Of course, that is sometimes easier said than done, but we should take heart that even the somewhat dense disciples portrayed in Mark's gospel were able to cast out demons and to heal many people. What a difference it would make in our world, if we could genuinely put our trust in Jesus, and tap into the power and ______ of God's kingdom!
- 3. Fourth, <u>my faith is **not** in my ability to improve myself, and not in my own sincerity</u>. Sincerity can be a good thing, but a person can be sincere and still be utterly wrong and misguided. And while self-improvement is also a reasonable and laudable goal, putting one's faith and trust solely in one's ability to improve oneself will eventually be shattered by the ______ of our human frailties.
- 4. And finally, sixth, <u>my faith is **not** in my power to tap some inner, godlike resources</u>. While God may indeed use us from time to time to execute his will and to demonstrate his power, we also know that "we have this treasure in clay ______ to show that the transcendent power belongs to God and not to us" (II Cor. 4:7).
- 5. Now, you might wonder why it is that Jesus would ask that his followers keep their lives and their travels very simple, without luxury and fanfare, without money or even food. That is because it helps them to trust in God and not in their ______ or their ability to control each situation with more than enough of everything.
