


The 2021-2022 study will be the Horizons's study What My Grandmothers Taught Me: Learning from the Women in Matthew's Genealogy of Jesus.

By using this digital method to send the Newsletter, the church is saving with both printing and mailing costs. If you prefer to have a copy mailed to you, please give the church office a call and let them know.




Teacher Supply Drive for Carter Jr. High
