

# Sermon Notes

Enter In... to Courage

Psalm 18:30-36; Matthew 25:14-30 (The Message)

Two key indicators that someone is operating out of fear:

- 1) Playing the blame game. "Master, I knew that you were a harsh man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you did not scatter seed." (verse 24)
- 2) Making excuses. "...so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground." (verse 25)

One opposite of fear is COURAGE.

- It takes courage to start giving.
- It takes courage to be faithful in your giving.
- It takes courage to expand and grow in your giving in the way God wants his children, his servants, to grow.

We want to Enter In...to Opportunity unless we allow fear and excuses to rob us of that. We want to Enter In...Now unless we allow fear and excuses to stall us, procrastinate, and thereby rob us of that.

We want to Enter In...and be Courageous unless we allow fear and excuses to rob us of that.
