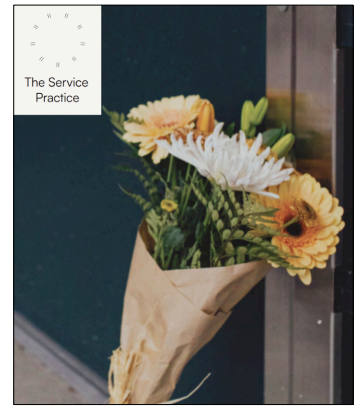

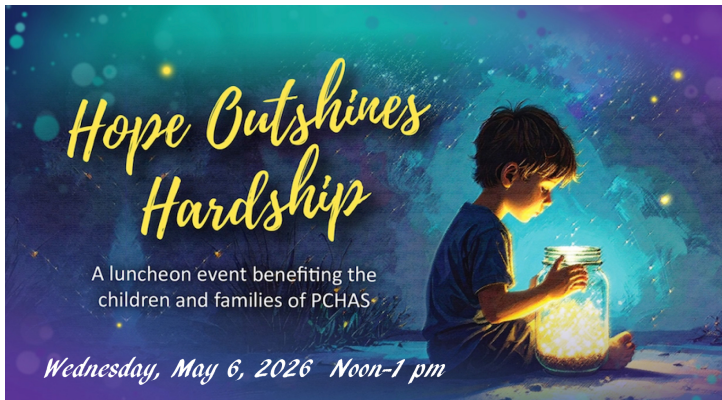

Celebrate with a bridal shower



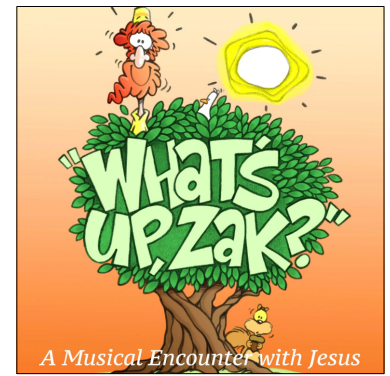
