



She holds a Doctor of Ministry from Fuller Seminary. Recently her book, *What to Say When You Pray* was published and is available on Amazon.

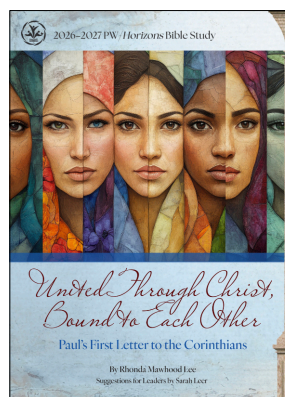
Community:
